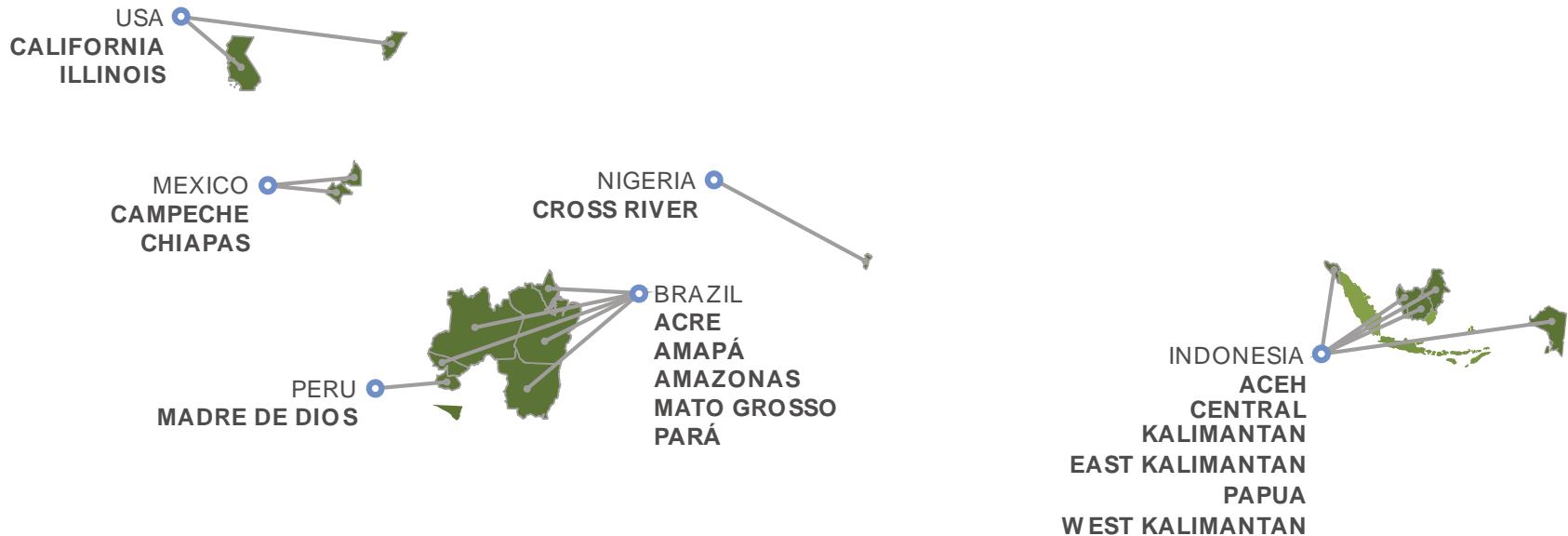


Increase the support and cooperation for the capacity building and technical assistance (readiness phase) among GCF members.
